INFORMATION NEEDED FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

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- Personal information (address, student ID number, date of birth, mailing address, etc.)
- High school education information (name and address of high school, cumulative GPA, academic honors received, high school transcript\*, etc.) **\*NOTE: transcripts should be sent directly by the institution**
- Secondary education information (name and address of institution, name and address of institution to receive scholarship funds if awarded, degree/certificate, estimated cost of completion, total scholarship amount applied for, previous/current enrollment history with institution, cumulative GPA, secondary education transcript\*, etc.) **\*NOTE: transcripts should be sent directly by the institution**
- Community involvement/leadership/employments/volunteerism (employment status and contact information if applicable, 5 year work history, volunteer/service experience, or school/community organization involvement, including the nature of your involvement, leadership positions, and dates)
- GFBF involvement (either as volunteer or recipient of programs/services)
- Verification of burn injury (document via the form provided or a letter from authorized medical professional) **Please do not send any medical records**

**DEADLINE: March 22, 2019 (spring application) or September 20, 2019 (fall application)**

Applications must be submitted online by 11:59pm on the respective deadlines for consideration. Applications received after the deadline will be considered the following application period.

**PLEASE NOTE: All supplemental application materials the applicant is responsible for (e.g. essay, invoice/billing statement, acceptance letter/enrollment verification, verification of burn injury, and release and agreement signature form) must be submitted at the same time. Options include:**

- 1. Uploaded at the end of the online application. Only PDF, Word, Excel, or JPEG files will be accepted. Maximum file size is 128MB. If online, materials must be submitted by 11:59pm on March 22 (spring application) or September 20 (fall application).**
- 2. Mailed to the GFBF office. If mailed to the GFBF office, materials must be postmarked on or before on March 22 (spring application) or September 20 (fall application).**

All other supplemental application materials (e.g. transcripts and letters of recommendation) should be mailed to the GFBF office and postmarked on or before on March 22 (spring application) or September 20 (fall application) directly from the institution or individual.

**APPLICATION CHECKLIST**

**All application materials must be received for consideration.**

- Online application
- One (1) Essay
- Two (2) letters of Recommendation\*\*
- Official High School Transcript or Official copy of GED\*\* (if applicable)
- Official University, College, Vocational, or Technical College Transcript\*\* (if applicable)
- Invoice/Billing Statement from University, College, or Technical College
- Copy of Acceptance Letter/Enrollment Verification from University, College, or Vocational, or Technical College (if applicable)
- Verification of burn injury
- Release and Agreement Signature Form
