## **OFFICIAL MISS BURN PAGEANT RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. A complete registration form, fact sheet and entry fee must be received at the Butts County Fire Department no later than Saturday, May 16, 2008. **NO EXCEPTIONS**
2. Make all checks payable to **Butts County Fire Rescue Fund**
3. We reserve the right to cancel and refund entry fees of any or all age divisions, due to lack of participation or unforeseen events.
4. Contestants will compete in the age division they are the day of the pageant.
5. Any display of uncooperative or unsportsmanlike conduct by the contestant or the parent/guardian, will result in disqualification. Contestants must be single, never have been married or ever had a child.
6. No past division Queens are eligible to enter the same age division.
7. All proceeds will be donated to the Georgia Firefighters Burn Foundation.
8. The contestant must be a resident of the state of Georgia.
9. Names of the contestants **WILL** not be given out. Please do not ask.
10. All contestants or parent/guardian for the each age divisions must attend the scheduled rehearsal.
11. All contestants will compete in formal wear.

**OFFICIAL MISS BURN PAGEANT RULES & REGULATIONS** continued

13. A Queen and four runners-up will be selected from each age division.
- a. All pageant Queens will receive: Crown – Trophy – Banner
  - b. Overall Winner will receive: Trophy-Crown-Banner
14. PHOTOGENIC PICTURES:
- a. Photogenic pictures cannot be any larger than 8x12.
  - b. Photogenic pictures must be labeled on the back with participant’s name, address, phone number, and age (day of pageant).
  - c. Only one photo can be entered per photogenic contestant.
  - d. Photos must be picked up after pageant.
15. The winning Miss Burn and Junior Miss Burn Queens agree to the following appearances as a representative of the Butts County Fire Department and the Georgia Firefighters Burn Foundation. (Dates to be announced):
- a. Ride in the Jackson/Butts County Christmas Parade
  - b. Participate in the annual Boot Drive
16. The First Runner-up must be willing and able to assume all duties in the event that the winner is unable or unwilling to fulfill her reign.
17. JUDGING & SCORING:
- a. Entrant agrees that the time, manner and method of judging shall be solely within the discretion of the pageant Board and the judge’s decisions are final. Score results will NOT be made public.
  - b. Baby Miss, Wee Miss, Toddler Miss, Tiny Miss, Little Miss & Young Miss Divisions:  
Judging will be based on the following:
    - ⌚ Beauty, Personality, and Attire
    - ⌚ Overall Impression & Group Review Rating
    - ⌚ Category 1 to 10. (with 10 being the highest)
  - c. Judging for the Miss Burn and Junior Miss Burn will be based on the following:
    - ⌚ Beauty & Formalwear/Modeling Technique
    - ⌚ Overall Impression & Group Review
    - ⌚ Category 1 to 10 (with 10 being the highest)
  - d. Overall judging will be based on the highest scores from beauty and photogenic
- There will be three overall winners chosen: one from newborn – 4 years old, one from 5 – 11 years old and one from 12 – 21 years old.
18. AUDITORIUM REGULATIONS:
- a. No food or drinks are allowed in the Auditorium.
  - b. All cell phones and pagers need to be turned off during the pageant program.
  - c. Contestants are allowed ONLY one person to assist them behind the stage. A pass will be provided.
